

Non-Government Organisations (NGOs)

- Identification of criminality (through reporting or other channels) requiring law enforcement action.
 - Prompt and timely crime reporting and sharing of intelligence.
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- When requested, NGOs deliver specialist training to police forces nationally.
 - To proactively identify problems, identify and allocate ownership and accountability and to work with other stakeholders to find solutions.
 - Work with Central Government to tackle the drivers of BoP crime.
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- Intelligence/crime data sharing between agencies.
 - To use Police crime recording standards when seeking official comment.
 - To Promote Op OWL.
 - To identify, share and promote examples of best practice



- Advice and guidance on best practice.
- Media campaigns to raise awareness of BoP crime.
- Op EASTER - multi-agency social media campaign to raise awareness of egg collecting.
- Operation GLASSBEAK – multi agency national operation to protect the most vulnerable nesting Peregrine falcons prior to and during the breeding season.
- To identify and target those individuals at high risk of offending, to divert them from involvement e.g. early intervention approach.
